



Concrete Construction Technology Course

- . Mix designs that have been successfully used. How to properly place, finish and cure this concrete.
- . How to successfully place concrete in hot and cold weather with good results. Mix designs, batching, curing procedures, and testing to meet these conditions.
- . Common concrete construction problems will be discussed. What causes these problems. How to prevent them and corrective action to be taken when they occur.
- . The common sense essentials to a successful concrete project such as: pre-construction meeting, ordering concrete, etc.
